Live with a host family in a shared or private bedroom. You will share bathroom and toilet facilities with the family. This option provides deep cultural immersion and strong local connections.

Guesthouse

Enjoy more privacy with a private bedroom, indoor toilet and bath, and a sitting area. Ideal for volunteers seeking comfort while staying close to the project location.

Volunteer Housing

A dedicated house for volunteers, located at or near the project site. This option allows for networking with other volunteers and offers a strong sense of community.
